Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is – his good, pleasing and perfect will. ³For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you.

⁴ **Just as each of us has one body with many member, and these members do not all have the same function,** ⁵ **so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.** ⁶ **We have different gifts, according to the grace given us.** If a woman's gift is prophesying, let her use it in proportion to her faith. ⁷If it is serving, let her serve; if it is teaching, let her teach; ⁸If it is encouraging, let her encourage; if it is contributing to the needs of others, let her give generously; if it is leadership, let her govern diligently; if it is showing mercy, let her do it cheerfully.
